Sunday Mass times will be 10:00 am (English) and 1:00pm (Spanish). Our Knights of Columbus have volunteered to participate as Safety Ushers in these masses to keep all of us safe. Please follow their guidance!

3) Parishioners must bring their own face coverings - that must be worn properly over the nose and mouth and mask must not have an exhale port which allows exhale with less restrictions.

Parishioners must arrive at Mass at least 30minutes prior to the start of Mass, i.e. at 9:30 and 12:30.

4) **THE BISHOP'S DISPENSATION FROM ATTENDING SUNDAY MASS WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT AND THE MASS WILL BE LIVESTREAMED(Facebook St. Marys's Group (<https://m.facebook.com/groups/616666051719052>) FOR THE FAITHFUL WHO DO NOT FEEL COMFORTABLE WITH ATTENDING IN PERSON. THE DISPENSATION WILL CONTINUE AS LONG AS OUR CHURCHES ARE NOT FULLY OPEN.** Parishioners in a vulnerable category are encouraged to stay at home (over 65 and/or immune-compromised) vice coming to mass.

8) **Communications.** We are now publishing electronically a Bulletin which is distributed via Flock notes and posted on our website. If you are not receiving it, you need to register on Flocknotes. You can sign up by **texting GUADALUPE to 84576** and following the instructions. If you need to do it in **Spanish then text GUADALUPE to 202-765-3441.**

If you do not text, you can still register with an email by going to <https://StMaryCatholicChurch12.flocknote.com/everyone>. Only a name and email is required to register but if you have a text number that is highly recommended to ensure you don't miss any important material. **Recently a number of people have been added to FLOCKNOTES using data from the parish's office records and CCD registration. Much of the data is incomplete so if you want to correct your data follow the above process to sign up on flocknotes. That will correct your data so you can manage your FLOCKNOTES account yourself. The data you put on flocknotes is secure.**
