2) Anyone needing to contact Father Roger should do so via Eleanor at the office during working hours (Mon/Tues/Wed) or via Cynthia Thursday 1-5, Friday 8-12, 1-7. (Office- 434-263-8509) For Emergency Use after hours the phone number at the rectory is 434-361-6007.

3) Public Masses at St Mary's continue. The following continue to apply for attendees at all masses during this COVID period and we ask that all follow this guidance.

Sunday Mass times will be 10:00 am (English) and 12noon (Spanish). Our Knights have volunteered to participate as Safety Ushers in these masses to keep all of us safe. Please follow their guidance! **Maintain social distancing (6feet) at all times.**

4) Parishioners must bring their own face coverings - that must be worn properly over the nose and mouth and mask must not have an exhale port which allows exhale with less restrictions.

Parishioners must arrive at Mass at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start to allow the ushers to properly seat persons andf maintain social distancing.

CHANGES TO OUR LITURGIACAL PROCEDURES DURING COVID- DUE TO THE GOVENOR MAKING SEVERAL CHANGES TO COVID PROTECTIONS OUR BISHOP HAS DIRECTED THE FOLLOWING.

I. LIMITED CELEBRATION OF PUBLIC MASS- no change to allowable numbers at mass as **social distance of 6 feet must be maintained and masks must be worn by all attending.** (the south wing and the Narthex are set up to handle an increase in attendance starting on Palm Sunday)

II. GUIDELINES FOR ALL LITURGICAL CELEBRTATIONS- parishes may **reinstitute altar servers.** (Father desires that one server be assigned for mass starting with the EASTER VIGIL)

-The dispensation from attending Sunday mass continues but the explanatory language is changed from for those in a vulnerable category to those **who have not received a vaccine and continue to feel uncomfortable returning to mass.**

-**Small choirs may resume.** (up to 8 individuals)

-Offertory and gift procession may resume. (Father desire this to begin on the Easter Vigil. The collection basket will not be passed but remain in the back of the church. **Parishioners are encouraged to deposit their offerings upon arrival at church . Ushers should leave one basket in the back for those that need to deposit after mass. Father desires an announcement by the Lector this weekend on the collection procedure.)(E-giving, or electronic giving is still preferred overall.)**

-Bulletins (paper) may be distributed.(Father is deciding on this. He is reviewing a pre-Covid bulletin. **Bulletins will continue to be posted on our website and sent via FLOCKNOTES)**

III. RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION BY THE FAITHFUL- No change for St. Mary

V. GUIDELINES FOR THE USE OF CHURCH BUILDINGS- Parishes may resume the use of paper, disposable worship aides. (**we will continue to put out missal books in the Narthex to be taken and retained by parishioners)**

VI. GUIDELINES FOR OTHER LITURGICAL AND SACRAMENTAL CELEBRATIONS- Updated the Confirmation language to reflect this years confirmation schedule(no change for St. Mary)

5) THE BISHOP’S DISPENSATION FROM ATTENDING SUNDAY MASS WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT AND THE MASS WILL BE LIVESTREAMED(Facebook St. Marys’s Group (<https://m.facebook.com/groups/616666051719052>) FOR THE FAITHFUL WHO HAVE NOT BEEN VACCINATED AND CONTINUE TO FEEL UNCOMFORTABLE WITH ATTENDING IN PERSON. THE DISPENSATION WILL CONTINUE UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.
